

Argyro Sgourou, is an Assistant Professor on "Cell structure and function" at the Hellenic Open University (HOU) and a tutor on the Undergraduate programme "Physical Sciences", since April 2016. She holds a PhD in "Molecular Biology and Genetics" obtained from Medical School (2001), University of Patras, under the funding of the "States Scholarship Foundation" of Greece. She has published 18 original papers (PubMed), 2 book chapters and over 40 papers in conference proceedings, of which 3 have been awarded.
