More precisely, the BIBLIO international webinar is entitled "[BIBLIO-Exchanging ideas on transforming Libraries in the digital age](#)", and takes place online on **Tuesday 29th March 2022, 14:30-16:00 (CET)**. Its main aim is to showcase

the BIBLIO approach of boosting digital skills and competencies for librarians in Europe.

- 🏛️ The first part of the webinar focuses on the modular approach of the educational curriculum and how BIBLIO assesses prior competencies and existing experience so that learners can adjust their learning path. The respective speeches will show how the educational courses are aligned with two European frameworks – DigComp and EntreComp, and also explain how the certification is achieved.
- 🏛️ The second part of the event is dedicated to exchanging ideas among the participants on concrete projects tackling the digital transformation of libraries. This session will also serve as inspiration for the participants in the BIBLIO Specialisation Courses (currently undergoing), who will start their apprenticeships in libraries across Europe during the summertime.
