George M. Agiomirgianakis is a Professor of Economic Theory and Policy at the Finance and Accounting Department of the Hellenic Mediterranean University since September 2020. He is vice president of the Hellenic Scientific Institute: Economics of Education & Life Long Learning, of Research & Innovation (I.EC.ED.LLL.R.IN.). Prior to this, he was Professor at the Hellenic Open University (HOU), Director of the Economic Analysis and Policy Lab, Academic Director of the undergraduate programmes Tourism Administration and Business Administration and of the Postgraduate Programmes: “Tourism Business Administration” (DTE), «Banking» (TPA) και «Enterprise Risk Management» (ERM) of HOU. He has served as Dean of the School of Social Sciences of HOU (2008-2012). His research interests lie in the areas of Economic Analysis and Policy, International Economics, Human Capital and the Role of Education, Labour Economics, Tourism Planning & Policy-Making, Tourism Education, Small Medium Enterprises, Macroeconomic Policy Games, Economic Growth and Foreign Direct Investment.
