The DAISSy Research Group of the Hellenic Open University (HOU) invites you to take part in a **webinar on Social Innovation**, entitled: "

Strengthening the role of civil society through participatory planning

Monday 3rd July 2023, 17.00'-19.00' (EEST)

The presentation will be held by Commonspace, which is a collaborative - interdisciplinary design team founded in 2012 that has created a specially structured methodology and a set of tools for participatory design of public space. In particular, the seminar will present Commonspace's recent project called "Local Watch". The project concerns an innovative technology platform, which includes all the tools necessary to facilitate the active participation of citizens in shaping the public life of the city they live in, while keeping the elected representatives of the city, liable according to their roles. At this stage, the Local Watch platform is operable at the four largest cities in Greece (Athens-Thessaloniki-Patras-Heraklion).

The project aims to design a Transnational Joint Master Programme (JM) in the field of Social Innovation.
