He worked as a Lecturer, then as an Assistant Professor and continues to teach as an Associate Professor at the Department of History and Archaeology of the National & Kapodistrian University of Athens for the subject of "Ancient Civilizations of the Eastern Mediterranean". Since 2011 he is directing an excavation in the Kurdistan Region in Iraq and since 2021 an excavation in Marchello in Palaepaphos (Cyprus). He published four books, 5 conference volumes and 45 papers in scientific journals or conference proceedings. Since 2017 he is a member of the Adjunct Academic Staff of the Hellenic Open University.
