





DAISSy-HOU call for the Survey on Shaping the Future of STE(A)M Education

If you are a *pre-service teacher, in-service teacher, principal, director, or school manager,* this is your time!

The "STE(A)M Education European Roadmap project-SEER" European project, currently undergoing with the DAISSy Research Group of the Hellenic Open University (HOU) as the Greek partner, supports the expansion of STE(A)M education in Europe, and it needs the insights into the current state of STE(A)M education across all levels and types of education.

Specifically, the main aim of the **SEER** project is to provide a set of roadmaps to pave the way for the policy and institutional changes, which are necessary for the large-scale implementation and mainstreaming of STE(A)M education in Europe.

Within this framework, a respective survey has been launched, aiming at shaping the roadmap for STE(A)M education and shed light on the needs of teachers and educators.
