

George Arambatzis Short CV

I studied film directing in Athens and, in Paris, at the University Paris 1, Cinema and Audiovisual Studies, and philosophy as a scholarship holder of the French Government.

I obtained my Ph.D. with distinction from the École de Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales. I conducted post-doctoral research at the University of Turin with a scholarship from the Italian Government. From 1998 to 2012, I was elected and worked as a Researcher at the Research Center for Greek Philosophy of the Academy of Athens.

In 2010, I was elected at the University of Athens where I was appointed in 2012 and have been teaching ever since. I have been a visiting Researcher-Professor at Princeton University (USA), at the University of Texas in Austin (USA), at the University of Helsinki (Finland), at Charles University in Prague (Czech Republic), at the University of Iași (Romania), etc.

I have given lectures at the aforementioned universities and others, while also teaching at the Philosophical School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (undergraduate and postgraduate), in the Postgraduate Program of the Philosophy department of the University of Athens and later at the Department of Philosophy, in the MSc "Ethical Philosophy" of the University of Peloponnese (Kalamata), at the Hellenic Open University, and at the Byzantine Department of the École de Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales.

I have participated with presentations in Greek and International Conferences and I am a member of Greek and International Philosophical Societies. I have extensively published in international and Greek scientific editions on topics within my specialization.

I have accumulated experience in distance education at the Hellenic Open University and at the Center for Lifelong Learning of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.

I have written about cinema and visual studies in a large number of publications, in books and articles. I have directed two short films. I have taught film aesthetics at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. Finally, I frequently write articles on film and audiovisual topics.

I am a member of the academic committee of the MSc "Philosophy and Arts" of the Hellenic Open University.
