Dr Anastasia Constantelou (She) is an Associate Professor of Innovation Management at the University of the Aegean, Department of Financial and Management Engineering. She holds a BSc in Informatics and Telecommunications from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, an MSc in Technology and Innovation Management and a PhD in Science and Technology Policy Studies, both from the University of Sussex. Before joining academia, Dr Constantelou was a consultant at the OECD working on telecommunications regulatory matters and on telecommunication numbering. Dr Constantelou has also served as Research Associate at the National Technical University of Athens, first at the Laboratory of Industrial and Energy Economics, and then at the Institute of Communication and Computer Systems (ICCP). Her current research interests focus on reforms and innovation policies for the public sector; on the design of support policies for innovation in the creative industries; and on dynamic capacity building in the public sector in the context of rolling the Smart Specialisation Strategy. Dr Constantelou has published widely and has presented her work in international conferences, also serving as Scientific Committee member in several of them. She is a regular reviewer in scientific journals in her field. Since 2020 she has been an Associate Editor in the *Electronic Markets* journal (Springer) where she also received the *Outstanding Reviewer Award 2020* for the quality of her scientific contribution in the journal.
