Applications shall be submitted exclusively electronically, as follows:

- From 10 April 2025, 11:59 a.m. to 25 August 2025, 11:59 a.m.

- From 10 April 2025 11:59 a.m. to 12 January 2026, 11:59 a.m.

for the PSP “Sports Studies: Sociology, History, Anthropology” (ASK) and “Contemporary Journalism Studies” (SDS) with courses starting in March 2026.

Applications for the PSP “Education Sciences: Special Education for People with Oral and Written Language Difficulties” (EAG) and “Master’s degree in Applied Developmental Psychology” (EAPS) shall remain open until 500 applications have been submitted to the former (EAG) and 260 to the latter (EAPS) and in any case no later than 11:59 a.m. on 25 August 2025.

- Studies are carried out remotely on the H.O.U. digital learning platform. Group Counseling Meetings (GCM) will also be held remotely.
- Applicants will be admitted into the programmes on a first-come, first-served basis, **based on the time of application.**
- **The first 130 applicants for the EAPS Postgraduate Programme will be admitted** (Category A:91, Category B:26, Category C:13) **and the remaining 130 places** (Category A:91, Category B:26, Category C:13) **will be designated as reserve places for any vacancies that may arise.** If the required number of places in one category is not filled, places in other categories may be filled, or vice versa.
- **The first 250 applicants for the EAG Postgraduate Programme will be admitted and the remaining 250 will be designated as reserve places for any vacancies that may arise. Applications shall remain open until 500 applications have been submitted.**
- **For the Interdisciplinary PSP PSA** the positions for the Ministry of Defense employees will be filled by the first 20 candidates and the remaining 20 places are designated as reserve places for the vacancies that may arise. If the places in this category are not filled, they will be available to the general category of candidates.
- Applications that exceed the limit of the available places are designated as reserve places.
- The H.O.U., in accordance with the provisions of article 35 of law no. 3794/2009 (GGC 156/v.A’), as amended by par. 24 of article 39 of law no. 4186/2013 (GGC 193/v.A’), par. 2 of article six of law no. 4218/2013 (GGC 268/v.A’), article 7 of law no. 4283/2014 (GGC 189/v.A’), par. 1 of article 13 of law no. 4452/2017 (GGC 17/v.A’), article 108 of law no. 4547/2018 (GGC 102/v.A’) and no. F.151/17897/B6/07.02.2014 (GGC 358/v.B’), as amended and in force, shall offer additional places (5%) in the Undergraduate Programmes for persons suffering from serious illnesses and falling under the aforementioned provisions.
- Persons who suffer from serious illnesses (law no. 3794/2009, GGC 156/v.A’) and submit applications for undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes are admitted in their entirety, provided they meet the admission requirements.
- Teaching material may be provided in printed and/or digital form.

- Once all applications have been examined, results (admissions, rejections) per programme will be announced as follows: (a) on 30th July 2025 for the candidates that submitted their applications till 30th June 2025 and (b) on 5th September 2025 for the candidates that will submit their applications till 25th August 2025. The results for PSP ASK and SDS will be announced on 4th February 2026.
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- Students participate in the costs associated with the application of the open and distance education system in accordance with the provisions of Law 5094/2024 (GGC 39/v.A’).
- By submitting their applications, candidates accept the conditions of admission, participation, and attendance in the Programme for which they have applied.
- Candidates must submit the necessary qualifications/skills (e.g. high school diploma) in addition to the required supporting documents by the closing date of the online application.
