Dimitris Petakos holds degrees in History and Philosophy of Science (BA, MA, PhD – NKUA) and in Communication, Media and Culture (BA – Panteion). Since 2020, he has been a postdoctoral researcher at the Institute of Informatics and Telecommunications, NCSR “Demokritos,” focusing on cultural projects, interactive exhibitions, and educational programs that connect the humanities with science and technology. He co-curates [AiTHERION](#), which develops cultural experiences on ancient Greek philosophy through new technologies.

He teaches Science Communication at the Hellenic Open University (2020-) and previously taught History of Science at NKUA (2016–2020). From 2010 to 2020, he collaborated with the Herakleidon Museum, the Aikaterini Laskaridis Foundation, and the Eugenides Foundation on educational programs and public talks on science communication. He is also the scriptwriter and narrator of three documentaries on the history of science. He was a member of the editorial team of PRISMA (2016-2024), a supplement of the newspaper Avgi dedicated to science, technology, and society.
