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Lambros Flitouris was born in Ioannina in 1975. He graduated from the Department of History and Archaeology at the School of Philosophy of the University of Ioannina (1996). He attended courses in European history and art history at the University of Strasbourg II. He holds postgraduate degrees in Modern and Contemporary Greek and European History from the Department of History and Archaeology of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (1996–1998), and in the History of International Relations from the Sorbonne–Paris 1 University (1999). He received his PhD in History from the Université de Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines (2004). Since 2004, he has been an associate member of the Centre d'Histoire Culturelle des Sociétés Contemporaines. He taught at the Department of Cultural Heritage Management and New Technologies of the University of Ioannina (2005–2008). He is a teaching fellow at the Hellenic Open University in the program European Civilization (module: General History of Europe). He is Associate Professor of 18th–20th century European History in the Department of History and Archaeology at the University of Ioannina (since 2008). He has been invited to lecture at the universities of Limoges, Versailles Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines, Lund, and Avignon.
