the School of Philosophy of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens; he holds a Master's Degree in Orthodox Theology from the School of Humanitarian Studies of the Hellenic Open University; he holds Ph.D in Ancient Greek Philosophy and Ph.D in Classical Studies. He served in private education from 1987 to 1996, public secondary education from 1996 to 2018, and as an officer from 2007 to 2015 and 2017 to 2018. Since January 2019 he is Faculty Member in the Supreme Ecclesiastical Academy of Athens (Department of Pastoral Studies), teaching Ancient Greek, Moral Philosophy, Ancient Greek Philosophy and Pedagogy. At the same time, he is a Consultant-Instructor in the Master "Performing Arts" at the Hellenic Open University. He was a Consultant- Instructor in the BA Program of Greek Culture at the Hellenic Open University and an Adjunct Lecturer at the Philology Department of the University of Peloponnese and the Higher School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE). From 2003 to 2014, he was also a member, Vice-President, and President of the Board of Directors of the Cultural Center of Thrakomakedones (Legal Entity of Public Law, L.E.P.L.) of the (old) Municipality of Thrakomakedones and (current) Municipality of Acharnes and was a founding member of the managing and scientific committee of the Interdisciplinary Lecture Center of the Municipality of Acharnes (DI. KE.DI.D.A). He has published fifty scientific papers and his research work focuses on Ancient Greek Philosophy, Dramatic Poetry, Pedagogy, and Moral Philosophy. He is the Special Assistant of the Hellenic Institute of Applied Pedagogy and Education (ELL.I.E.P.EK) and since 2012 he organizes Philosophical Counseling Seminars and participates in the lecture program of the University Elefthero Panepistimio of Kifissia.
