In the period between 2006-2019, she worked as a Senior Investigator at the Greek Ombudsman authorized for Health, Social Security, Bioethics, and Social Solidarity affairs.

She also served (2019-2023) in the Bureau of Deputy Minister of Health as a Legal Counselor responsible for the elaboration of provisions and legislation introduced to the Parliament.

Eirini Kyriakaki is a member of the Teaching Staff of the EKDDA, lecturing on Health Law, Patient's Rights and Bioethics. She has also been assigned to teach Public Servant's Law at the National Open University, Athens.

Her scientific interests focus in particular on the protection of the human and the fetus in the context of biomedical research, clinical trials of drugs, issues of medical ethics and medical responsibility, the rights of patients/users of health services, the use of stem cells for research and therapeutic purposes, in matters of medically assisted reproduction and research ethics, as well as in particular matters of administrative law.

Eirini Kyriakaki is the author of monographies along with independent contributions in collective volumes and scientific articles in international and Greek scientific journals.
