Through modern educational methods and real case studies, participants will gain valuable experience and will use practical tools for designing, implementing, and evaluating innovative solutions that will contribute to sustainable social development in one the most dynamic Macro-Regions of Europe.

At the teaching level it will focus on the field of "**Data Analysis and Participatory Design for Social Innovation**".
